Drawn concurrently with the Non Pro Snaffle Bit Futurity or Non Pro Derby. Eligible entries may cross enter into both divisions and entitled to a credit of \$362.25 for cattle, judges, partial office & GST

\*\*\* Limited to Non Pro riders with less than \$7500 lifetime Reined or Working Cow Horse earnings excluding limited aged event earnings. Drawn concurrently with the Non Pro Bridle. Eligible entries may cross enter into both divisions and are entitled to a credit of \$105 for cattle, judges, partial office fees & GST.

## Terms & Conditions

### General

1. Futurity Entries- Open to 3 yr .old horses of any breed. All horses are to be shown in 3 rounds of competition: herd, rein & cow work. Horses may have been previously exhibited in a snaffle bit, hackamore or bridle; however, they may not have been shown down the fence in a bridle.
2. Derby Entries: Open to horses 4 & 5 yrs. of age of any breed that have never been shown in a bridle down the fence at any judged cow horse event held anytime, any place. Horses to be shown in an approved hackamore with closed reins, or approved snaffle bit in herd, rein & cow work rounds of competition.
3. Bridle Entries: Open to horses of any age, any breed to be ridden in an approved bit. Horses to be shown in rein & cow work. Only one hand may be used on the reins & hands must not be changed.
4. Non Pro division must meet current ARCHANA Non Pro requirements .
5. Owners & riders must be current members in good standing with the ARCHANA by noon the day preceding competition.
6. All entries must be named, and a copy of the horse's registration papers or a written veterinary age authentication including complete horse description for unregistered horses included for Futurity & Derby classes, at the time of entry. Failure to include a copy of registration papers or veterinary age authentication will constitute an incomplete entry (Futurity & Derby classes only).
7. Prize money will be paid to the party designated on the entry form. All payees must be members of the ARCHANA. Prize money will be paid out in accordance with current ARCHANA payout schedule & rules.
8. An owner may enter more than one horse. A rider may ride more than one horse. A horse may only be entered once in each division.
9. The Snaffle Bit Futurity Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All decisions are final.
10. The ARCHANA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the Futurity & Championships without notice &/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest earned on the entries is the property of the ARCHANA.
11. ARCHANA rules will apply unless specifically deleted or altered.
12. These rules & conditions are subject to change by action of the ARCHANA Board of Directors &/or Snaffle Bit Futurity Committee on behalf of the ARCHANA Board of Directors.
13. Ties for first place will be broken by the highest cow work score. In the event cow work scores are the same, the tied contestants will have a work off in the cow work portion only to determine the winner. Ties below first place will split the payout for the tied places, prizes will be determined by highest cow work score & if still tied then will be determined by coin flip. Ties for any special award prizes will be determined by coin flip.

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### Equipment

1. Snaffle Bit Futurity: Entries will be shown in a standard headstall (brow band, shaped ear or split ear but must include a throat latch) using a "D" ring or "O" ring type snaffle with an inside ring diameter no larger than 4". Bits must have a broken mouthpiece being a minimum 5/16" in diameter measured 1" in from the corners, with a gradual decrease to centre of the snaffle. The mouthpiece should be round, oval or egg shaped, smooth & unwrapped metal. It may be inlaid, but smooth or latex wrapped. These bits must be such that when the reins are pulled no undue leverage is applied (i.e. the inside of the circumference of the ring must be free of rein, curb or head stall attachments). Leather or other woven material chinstrap to be used. No iron, chain or other material will be allowed. Reins to be attached above the chinstrap. Split or tied reins may be used. Entries must be shown with both hands on the reins, except in the herd work portion of the competition or to provide safety to the rider or adjust equipment.
2. Derby: Entries will be shown in either a Snaffle Bit or Hackamore (same for all 3 disciplines). If using a snaffle bit entries, will be shown in a standard headstall (brow band, shaped ear or split ear but must include a throat latch) using a "D" ring or "O" ring type snaffle with an inside ring diameter no larger than 4". Bits must have a broken mouthpiece being a minimum 5/16" in diameter measured 1" in from the corners, with a gradual decrease to centre of the snaffle. The mouthpiece should be round, oval or egg shaped, smooth & unwrapped metal. It may be inlaid, but smooth or latex wrapped. These bits must be such that when the reins are pulled no undue leverage is applied (i.e. the inside of the circumference of the ring must be free of rein, curb or head stall attachments). Leather or other woven material chinstrap to be used. Reins to be attached above the chinstrap. Split or tied reins may be used. If using a hackamores the hackamore shall be round in shape & constructed of uniform braided rawhide &/ or leather & have a flexible core. No gimmick of any kind may be used in conjunction with the bosal. No rigid material of any kind may be used, regardless of how padded or covered, in conjunction with the bosal. Horsehair bosals are prohibited. Closed reins will be used.
3. Bridle: Entries to be shown in an ARCHA Working Cow Horse approved bit, leather curb strap with romal reins. (See ARCHA rulebook for details).
4. General: After each work, headstalls must be dropped and viewed by the appointed representative and mouth checked. Size and design of horseshoes will be the exhibitor's discretion. Use of illegal &/or training equipment will not be permitted in the show arena on the day of the show, either previous to or during the performance. Exhibitors must wear a western hat or helmet approved for riding by an equine organization, boots & long sleeve shirt, chaps or chinks are mandatory. On show day & until the conclusion of the show, any persons entering the show pen must be wearing a western hat and long sleeve shirt. If at any time during a performance a piece of equipment breaks, the rider may continue provided the broken equipment does not pose a hazard to the rider &/or is not cruel to the horse. If the rider is not able to continue due to the broken equipment, the rider will be excused with a score of zero.

### Scratches

If an entry is scratched, all fees will be forfeited. No refunds shall be given except in the event of death or a disabling injury to a horse. The owner of said horse must provide written verifications of such from an approved Veterinarian. Any veterinary fees will be the responsibility of the horse owner. If the owner provides written verification prior to the draw, Nov. 4, 2011, the owner will be refunded half of the office fee & half of the cattle fee. After the draw, no refunds will be given.

### Substitutions:

1. Rider Substitutions: Rider substitutions can be completed by contacting the ARCHA Office. Rider substitutions may be subject to the Snaffle Bit Committee's approval (i.e. Non-Pro).
2. Horse Substitutions: In order to complete a horse substitution the following items must be sent to the ARCHA office or presented to the Horse Show office at the show:
  - A substitution fee of 10% of the total entry fee.
  - A copy of the new entry's registration papers or veterinary age authentication (Futurity & Derby classes only).
  - new entry blank must be completed.

Any current entry that would like to substitute must provide all the items listed above or it will be considered a late entry & will be assessed late entry fees at the time of entry.
3. Change of ownership: If any entry changes ownership, the entry will retain eligibility by complying with the following:
  - Notification of change in ownership to the ARCHA office.
  - New owner is or becomes a member of the ARCHA.

Payment of Fees:

1. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure payments of fees are received by Nov. 1, 2011. The ARCHA will not be responsible for entries or payments received late. Payments must be received or secured on or before the due date. There will be no grace period or exceptions. Payments returned due to insufficient funds or denied credit card will constitute an incomplete entry, a \$50 NSF charge will also be assessed. Incomplete entries are subject to refusal after the due date. Entries may be made by mail or e-mail (fax is not available).
2. Entry fees are payable by cheque, cash, Visa or MasterCard. Credit card payments are subject to a 4% service charge. Payments & entries must be received on or before Nov. 1 2011. No exceptions. Note if you would like to use your Credit Card to guarantee entry & pay by cash or cheque, please indicate & the ARCHA will accommodate, no 4% service charge will apply unless used, NSF charge will apply to any dishonored cheques or credit card charges. ARCHA reserves the right to charge dishonored cheques to the credit card used to secure entries.
3. All entries will be acknowledged by e-mail or phone.

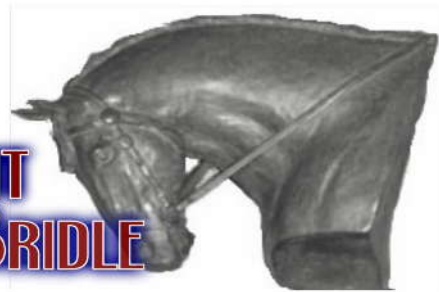
