GENERAL RULES FOR ENTRY

- 1. Owners and riders must be members of both ARCHA and NRCHA. Membership and non pro declaration (if applicable) must be signed prior to showing.
- 2. NRCHA Rules apply to all classes please refer to NRCHA rulebook at NRCHA.com
- 3. Horse show classes only: an owner may enter more than one horse. A rider may ride more than one horse. A horse may only be entered once in each division. Please see CGH for terms and conditions of that entry.
- 4. Grade horses (not registered under any breed association) must complete the Grade Competition License available from the show secretary.
- 5. If horse is unregistered and entered in a non pro class, contestant must provide proof of ownership.
- 6. Non pros can't show under a transfer report, the registration must be transferred to the contestant prior to the show.
- 7. The ARCHA reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All decisions are final.
- 8. The ARCHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice &/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest earned on the entries is the property of the ARCHA.
- 9. These rules & conditions are subject to change by action of the ARCHA Board of Directors &/or Committee on behalf of the ARCHA Board of Directors.

SCRATCHES & SUBSTITUTIONS

SCRATCHES: If an entry is scratched on or before midnight June 23rd, any prepaid fees will be returned and/or the entrant will not be responsible for fees. After June 23rd, contestant will be charged the add back and half of the office/cattle charge. After June 25th midnight, any scratched entries will be responsible for all fees and as per NRCHA Rules will remain listed on the posted draws. Vet certificates do not effect the scratch policies/fees.

LATE ENTRIES: \$75 Late Fee / Horse Show Class for entries received after midnight on Entry Deadline, up until cattle order. Late entries will be accepted on a discretionary basis after cattle order, with late fee. Please see CGH terms and conditions for late entries for CGH.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Rider Substitutions: Rider substitutions can be completed by contacting the show secretary via entries@cowhorse.ca . Rider substitutions may be subject to the Show Committee's approval.

Horse Substitutions: In order to complete a horse substitution, the following items must be sent to the show secretary at entries@cowhorse.ca: A copy of the new entry's registration papers or veterinary age authentication.

PAYMENT

- 1. Upon submission of entry the office will forward invoice for payment which can be made via credit card, etransfer or cheque.
- 2. E transfers to info@cowhorse.ca
- 3. Credit card payment, 4% will be added to invoice
- 4. Cheques payable to: Alberta Reined Cow Horse Association should be dropped off at show office
- 5. All show invoices are due by the end of show day July 2, 2023
- 6. Payments returned due to insufficient funds will be subject to all late fees upon re-entry and a \$50 NSF charge will also be assessed. Owners and/or contestants with payments returned due to insufficient funds will be reported to the NRCHA office and subject to NRCHA penalties (refer to NRCHA rulebook).
- 7. Owners and/or contestants with accounts in arrears will be reported to the NRCHA, and will no longer be considered members in good standing.


















CANADA'S GREATEST HORSEMAN

- 1. Entries must use the Entry form and submitted via email see above.
- 2. Canada's Greatest Horseman is a category 1 Special Event that will consist of five go rounds
 - a.herd work
 - b. steer stopping
 - c.reined work / cow work
 - d.fence finals.
- 3. It is open to all breeds of any age regardless of show history. Open & Non Pro Riders are encouraged to enter.
- 4. Exhibitors may show only one horse. An owner may enter more than one horse provided there is a different rider for each entry.
- 5. All horses much be shown in the same bridle throughout all phases. No tie-downs will be permitted. The traditional bridle with romal reins must be used. The hand is to be around the reins in a fist position with thumb up and no fingers between the reins. In the herd work only, romal reins can be held in one hand. Roping reins are optional in the Steer Stopping. The same bit must be used throughout the contest and will be documented at the end of each round.
- 6. Electric eye / timer will be used in the steer stopping round.
- 7. Total added money for Canada's Greatest Horseman is \$15,000.
- 8. A \$2500 incentive will be awarded to the highest scoring non-pro entered in the competition. To be eligible for the Non-Pro side pot, a second NRCHA fee will be charged.
- 9. Late entries will be accepted up to draw date with \$250 late fee.

SUMMER SPECTACULAR HORSE SHOW

- 1. Entries are due Monday, June 19th. Management reserves the right to extend deadline pending entries. Late entries will be accepted with an additional \$75 up to draw date, and on a discretionary basis after draw date pending cattle availability.
- 2. Entries must be submitted via email or using online system at www.cowhorse.ca or email to entries@cowhorse.ca
- 3. Copy of horse papers must be submitted to office prior to showing unless papers have been submitted for prior show
- 4. Classes that are NRCHA approved, one entry fee qualifies you for both NRCHA and ARCHA year end points, subject to eligibility. Payout is based on NRCHA and you ride for points for ARCHA. In the case of L1 non pro bridle and limited open classes, there may be a possibility where you are eligible for NRCHA but not ARCHA. You can still enter the class, same fee, but you will not be included in the ARCHA year end points.
- 5. Summer Spectacular Aggregate Awards will be offered in all horse show classes with the exception of ancillary classes # 14, 27, 32, 84 ARCHA Classes # 34, 35, 37 & Cutting Classes #1-6, 100, 102.
- 6. Summer Spectacular Aggregate Prize Money is paid out as a NRCHA Category 2 Horse Show, meaning the prize money will count towards LTE, but not Merit Awards.
- 7. An additional \$10 NRCHA Fee will apply to any entries in the Aggregate Prize Money classes listed: Open Bridle (12), Open Hackamore (31), Limited Open Hackamore (33), Non Pro Bridle (21), Int. Non Pro Bridle (22), Limited Non Pro Bridle (23), Non Pro Boxing (81)
- 8. Classes that run concurrent (common draw) are as follows:
 - a. Open/Limited Open/Intermediate Open Bridle
 - b. Non Pro/L1 Non Pro/Intermediate Non Pro Bridle/Non Pro Bridle Select
 - c. Non Pro Hackamore/Non Pro Snaffle Bit-Hackamore (ARCHA)
