- Spectaculars will run concurrent with Horse Show #2 Classes (Sunday) cross entry discount of \$75 if entered in both.
- Non Pro Boxing is not a bridle spectacular. Can you use legal equipment for age of horse
- Entered in both Non Pro and L1 NP spectacular discount of \$110

## LAE Draw date: May 17, 2024

# Horse Show Draws will be made after 5 pm the day prior to show.

- 1. Owners and riders must be members both ARCHA and NRCHA members. Membership and non pro declaration (if applicable) must be signed prior to showing.
- 2. NRCHA Rules apply to all classes please refer to NRCHA rulebook at NRCHA.com
- 3. Back Numbers will be required for Cowtown Derby 2024.
  - a. Use of back numbers will follow NRCHA General Rules for Show & Contest 1.1.5 (Page 14)
  - b. In order to receive a back number pre-payment of show fees, or a method of payment MUST be on file with the show office.
- 4. An owner may enter more than one horse. A rider may ride more than one horse. A horse may only be entered once in each division.
- 5. The ARCHA reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. All decisions are final.
- 6. The ARCHA reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the event without notice &/or liability. In the event of cancellation all entry fees paid to date will be refunded. Any interest earned on the entries is the property of the ARCHA.
- 7. These rules & conditions are subject to change by action of the ARCHA Board of Directors &/or Committee on behalf of the ARCHA Board of Directors.

### DERBY

Entries must use the Entry form and submitted via email – see above:

- 1. Derby entries will be accepted until May 13 at Midnight. Late entries will be accepted with an additional \$150 up to May 16 at 5 pm.
- 2. By submitting an entry, in any format, the contestant acknowledges that they meet the criteria to compete in the classes entered according to the guidelines set forth in the NRCHA rulebook.
- 3. Open to horses 4 & 5 years of age (6 years for Non Pro Boxing Derby only, but can't be shown in a hackamore) of any breed that have never been shown in a bridle down the fence at any judged cow horse event held anytime, anyplace. Horses to be shown in an approved hackamore with closed reins, or approved snaffle bit in herd, rein & cow work rounds of competition (must use same equipment in all three events).



- 4. All entries must provide a copy of the horse's registration papers or a written veterinary age authentication. Failure to include a copy of registration papers or veterinary age authentication will constitute an incomplete entry.
- 5. Grade horses (not registered under any breed association) must complete the Grade Competition License available from the show secretary.
- If horse is unregistered and entered in a non pro class, contestant must provide proof of ownership. <u>Non pros</u> can't show under a transfer report, the registration must be transferred to the contestant prior to the show.
- 7. Open and Limited Open One fee enters riders in the eligible classes. Payout split 80/20.
- 8. Non Pro and Limited Non Pro One fee enters riders in the eligible classes. Payout split 80/20.

#### HORSE SHOW

- 1. Entries are due Monday, May 13. Late entries will be accepted with an additional \$75 up to 5 pm the day before show date.
- 2. Entries must be submitted via email or using online system at <u>www.cowhorse.ca</u> or email to <u>entries@cowhorse.ca</u>

By submitting an entry online, you agree to the following:

## By my entry submission I hereby acknowledge that I meet the criteria to compete in the classes entered according to the guidelines.

- 3. Copy of horse papers must be submitted to office prior to showing unless papers have been submitted for prior show
- 4. Classes that are NRCHA approved, one entry fee qualifies you for both NRCHA and ARCHA year end points, subject to eligibility. Payout is based on NRCHA and you ride for points for ARCHA. In the case of L1 non pro bridle and limited open classes, there may be a possibility where you are eligible for NRCHA but not ARCHA. You can still enter the class, same fee, but you will not be included in the ARCHA year end points.
- 5. Classes that run concurrent (common draw) are as follows:
  - a. Open/Limited Open/Intermediate Open Bridle
  - b. Non Pro/Limited Non Pro/Intermediate Non Pro Bridle/Non Pro Bridle Select
  - d. Open/Intermediate Open Hackamore
  - e. Youth Boxing / Youth Boxing 13 & under
  - f. Non Pro Boxing/Intermediate Non Pro Boxing
  - g. Youth Cow Horse/ Youth Cow Horse 13 & under
- 6. See entry form for cross entry discount(s).
- 7. Riders are responsible to check in to office prior to class to verify entry.

### SCRATCHES

If an entry is scratched **on or before** midnight May 13<sup>th</sup> (Entry Deadline), any prepaid fees will be returned and/or the entrant will not be responsible for fees. After May 13, contestant will be charged the add back and half of the office/cattle charge. After May 17, any scratched entries will be responsible for all fees and as per NRCHA Rules will remain listed on the posted draws LAE classes.

#### SUBSTITUTIONS

1. Rider Substitutions: Rider substitutions can be completed by contacting the show secretary via <u>entries@cowhorse.ca</u>. Rider substitutions may be subject to the Show Committee's approval.



- 2. Horse Substitutions: In order to complete a horse substitution, the following items must be sent to the show secretary at <a href="mailto:entries@cowhorse.ca">entries@cowhorse.ca</a>:
  - A copy of the new entry's registration papers or veterinary age authentication.

## PRACTICE WORKS

Pre-sign up with entry is required for guaranteed practice works including reining, cutting & fence/boxing. Additional fence / boxing practices may be available at the show based on availability & sign up. Method of payment (blank cheque/credit card) needs to be submitted to show office for billing prior to working. Used cattle cutting practice will be available during the herd work day of show.

### PAYMENT

- 1. Upon submission of entry the office will forward invoice for payment which can be made via credit card, etransfer or cheque.
- 2. E transfers to info@cowhorse.ca
- 3. Credit card payment, 4% will be added to invoice
- 4. Cheques payable to: Alberta Reined Cow Horse Association should be dropped off at show office
- 3. All show fees MUST BE paid no later than Saturday May 25, 2024 at 5 pm.
- 4. Payments returned due to insufficient funds will be subject to all late fees upon re-entry and a \$50 NSF charge will also be assessed. Owners and/or contestants with payments returned due to insufficient funds will be reported to the NRCHA office and subject to NRCHA penalties (refer to NRCHA rulebook).
